The proposed Class B airspace graphic is attached. The final configuration will be published on the Chicago Sectional Chart.

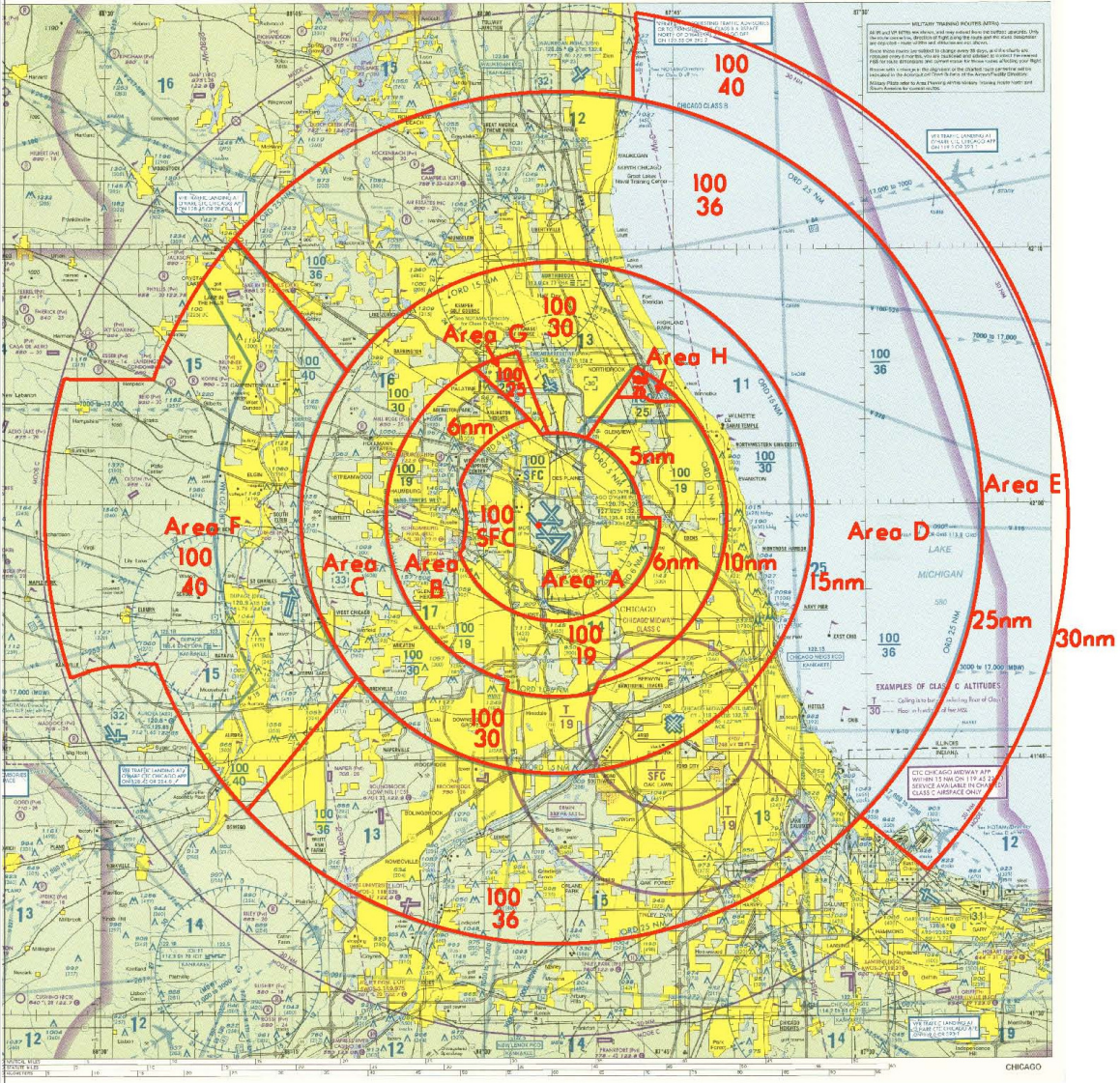
